## PURPOSE

To announce the appointment of Angie Logan as the DPW Policy Director. Angie will be replacing Julia Hinckley who has accepted a position with CMS/HHS in Washington D.C.

## DISCUSSION

Angie Logan will become the DPW Policy Director, effective in early August. Angie takes on this role with significant experience at DPW, including her current position as a lead policy analyst in the DPW Office of Policy Development. Her responsibilities include coordinating, planning and program activities across mental health, developmental disabilities, child welfare, early childhood, Medicaid and education. Ms. Logan currently manages a budget of \$4 million for cross-system children's projects including the Integrated Children's Services Planning and Sanctuary Trauma Informed Care Initiatives. Prior to Commonwealth employment, Angie was a Project Investigator for the evaluation of Early to Learn; she was responsible for managing grants and contracts related to school readiness and early childhood education. While working as a senior research analyst and adjunct professor at the Center for Public Policy, Angie received a master's degree in Political Science from Temple University in Philadelphia and is currently ABD. She has published several articles in the American Political Science Review's PS Political Science Journal. Angie is the proud mother of a 3 ½ year old - Logan Jules Novak.
